 Pedal off the beaten path in one of Tennessee's largest counties, named for Revolutionary War hero General "Mad Anthony" Wayne.

This year we start in Collinwood and explore the north end of the county along routes developed by experienced cyclists that follow a variety of rural, hilly, shady and sunny routes.

You will ramble through wooded hills with spring-fed creeks and lush valleys that are home to cattle, deer and wild turkey. All routes include the Natchez Trace Parkway. Century and metric century routes will travel along the Tennessee River through Historic Clifton. The century tour will also take in portions of neighboring Lewis and Perry Counties.

The bakers of Wayne County provide you with home-made cookies, and other refreshments include pure Wayne County spring water and more at rest stops.

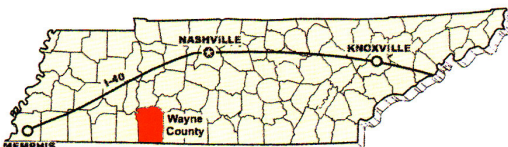
 Routes of 105, 67, 33 and 20 miles will take you on predominantly well-paved roads. There is one stretch of lightly traveled tar and chip county roads.

This is a tour and not a race. Plan to ride at a rate appropriate to your training and road conditions.

There are challenging hills on the longer routes, so please be sure you are adequately trained and that your bike, including tires and brakes, is in good working order.

**Services:** Rest and refreshment stops will be provided along the route, with sandwiches at the end of the ride. Sag support and showers will be provided until 3 p.m. Bring your own soap and towel.

Collinwood is a quaint little town located just off the Natchez Trace Parkway. Overnight lodging is available at Miss Monetta's Country Cottage or Coast to Coast Rooms in Collinwood. The Hurricane Inn in Waynesboro, The Cedars at Ross Creek and The Bear Inn River Resort in Clifton are also recommended locations to stay.
